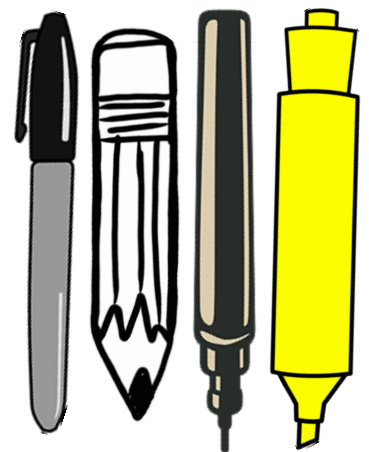
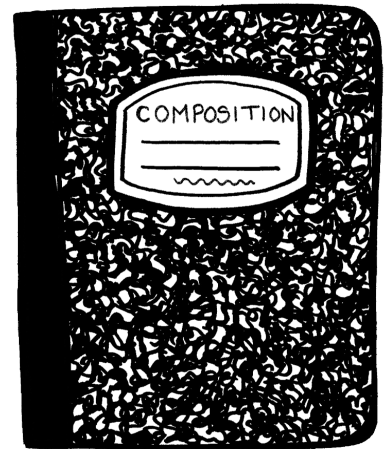
GRADING POLICY
